

2023 - 2024 Dress Code

STUDENTS MUST COME TO SCHOOL EACH DAY DRESSED FOR SUCCESS. ANY STUDENTS IN VIOLATION OF THE DRESS CODE WILL RECEIVE A DRESS CODE VIOLATION SLIP. FURTHER DRESSCODE VIOLATION WILL RESULT IN FURTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

- Shirts must be <u>collared</u>, tucked in all the way around <u>or</u> a LCYAA uniform t-shirt.
- Students must wear solid colored uniform pants, or blue jeans.
- <u>Solid colored</u> uniform shorts, or blue jean shorts may be worn, and must touch the top of the knee.
- Dresses must have a collar, and be knee to ankle length.
- Belts are not required; however, pants must be worn at the waist.
- All shoes must have a back or back strap. Straps and laces must be properly fastened and closed toe.
- Pierced jewelry may be worn in the <u>ears only</u>.
- Sweatshirts must be LCYAA school uniform apparel ONLY.
 LCYAA Uniform Sweatshirts can be purchased/ordered in the front office.

↓ NOT PERMITTED ↓

- Shirts other than collared shirts or LCYAA uniform t-shirt.
- Dresses without a collar or that are shorter than knee length.
- Athletic style shorts: basketball shorts, lounge shorts, or bike shorts.
- Leggings, athletic-style pants: warm-up/track pants, yoga pants, tearaway pants, or lounge pants.
- Pants or shorts that are frayed, torn, cut, or have chains, holes, or multiple zippers.
- Flip flops, slide sandals, Croc styled shoes or "Foam RNNR" styled shoes.
- Pierced jewelry anywhere other than in ears. No gauge or plug earrings.
- Jackets, sweatshirts, or sweaters other than LCYAA Uniform Sweatshirts.
